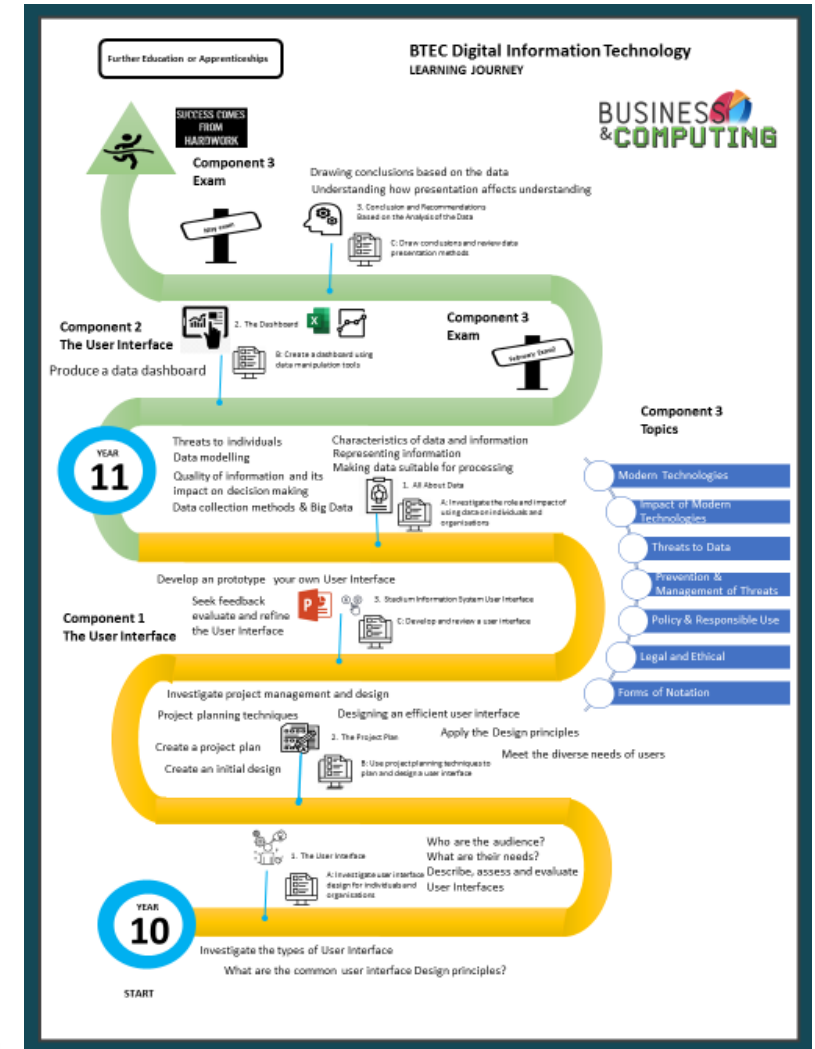
What to expect on this course?
