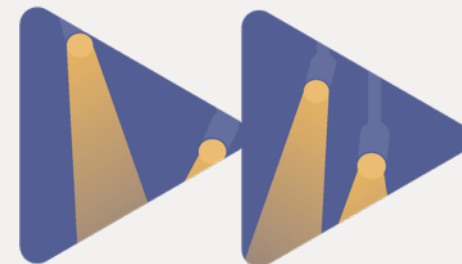

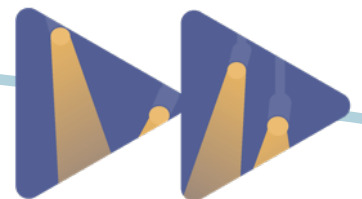
**Have you ever considered where studying Drama can take you?**

**DRAMA AND MUSIC**  
**WE'VE GOT THE APPRENTICESHIP FOR YOU!**

**CREATIVE VENUE TECHNICIANS**  
provide technical support for the construction, rehearsal, presentation and removal of a live performance.

**ARTS THERAPISTS**  
use art, drama or music to carry out therapy interventions to improve mental, physical health and wellbeing.

**EVENT ASSISTANTS**  
work in an events company or events department in an organisation, helping event planners and project managers to organise and host events.

**LIVE EVENT TECHNICIANS**  
set up technical equipment for live events ranging from concerts, festivals and theatrical performances through to exhibitions, conferences, product launches and showcases.

**BROADCAST PRODUCTION ASSISTANTS**  
support and assist the delivery of content for TV or radio shows, including factual, light entertainment, drama, comedy, documentary and current affairs.
