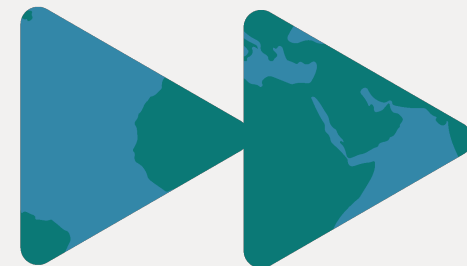

help to improve local, regional, national and international transport systems.

**AVIATION OPERATORS**  
manage the environment, facilities and services at airports and other airfields - including the safe arrival, turnaround and departure of aircraft.

**COMMUNITY ENERGY SPECIALISTS**  
reduce energy use and purchase, manage and generate low carbon heat and power to reduce carbon emissions and waste.

**NUCLEAR SCIENTIST AND NUCLEAR ENGINEERS**  
ensure nuclear systems and equipment operate safely and efficiently and in an environmentally sustainable way.

**SURVEYING TECHNICIANS**  
collect information from site inspections to inform advice to clients on land, property or construction.
