Dear Parent/Carer

Wednesday 29th March – Go Ape Coventry

I am delighted to inform you that we are running a reward trip as part of our school's Recognition Week. The purpose of the trip is to reward students who have consistently produced high standards of behaviour and attendance since the start of term. At the start of term students were informed of the trip and the following criteria of:

- No more than 1 spell of absence
- No more than 5 behaviour points
- Have had no more than 5 late marks to AM/PM registration
- Have had no internal or external exclusions.

This will be our criteria for all reward trips that the school runs for KS4 students. At the start of each term students will be given the opportunity to reach the criteria within a selected time period, allowing all students to access future reward trips.

At the start of term students were given a choice of 4 different trips; the decision to have the Easter reward trip take place at Go Ape was the overwhelmingly popular choice. We have listened to the interest from the students have expressed and are delighted to support their decision.

Students will need to arrive at school as per the normal school day at 8:40am and make their way straight down to the hall to be registered. During this time students who are eligible for Grab Bags for lunch can collect them. Students will leave school via coaches at approximately 8:50am. We aim to arrive at Go Ape Coventry for 10:00am, students will then go through a safety briefing and demonstration with the course instructors. Students will be split into 2 groups, one group will have an early lunch while the other groups completes the course and then swap over. Students will get 2 hours' worth of activity time. After both groups have completed the course students will leave Go Ape Coventry at approximately 2:30pm and return to school at 3:30pm where they can then leave school and return home. Students will be attached throughout the course using Go Ape Coventry's continuous belay system and supervised at all times.

Your child does not have to wear school uniform but will be expected to behave according to our code of conduct at all times. We suggest that your child wears suitable clothing which is comfortable, practical and that students do not mind being potentially damaged. With the weather being unpredictable please ensure your child brings a warm coat for the day. Go Ape remains open throughout most weather conditions, however should the site be closed due to extreme weather conditions, the trip will be rearranged or a full refund will be given. We anticipate a large number of our students will hit the eligibility criteria for this trip, therefore we must stress that there are a limited number of places available for the trip and students will be given a ticket on a strictly first come first served basis. Please can you return the reply slip attached with the (\underline{f}) and hand in to the finance office.

1.1 am 16+ years ald and wish to undertake the Treetop Challenge organised by Go Ape.

2. Lunderstand that the Treetop Challenge consists of a physically demanding aerial obstacle course and that there will be a risk of injury when understaking it. For example, legs can be vulnerable to injury on tip wire landings and hands can be injured on Tartan Swings. I understand that should I disconnect from the lately system I am at risk of a fall from height. Adults supervising participants are responsible for ensuring participants under their supervision are using the methods of attactment provided in accordance with the Safety Rules. However, as with any physical activity there remains a degree of risk even where the Safety Rules are followed, and the Activity can be physically, mentally and emotionally demanding.

 To reduce the risks, I agree to read and follow the instructions set out in the Safety Rules and follow all instructions given to me by Go Ape staff before and during the Treetop Challenge.
