A full campus map is enclosed at the end of this invitation and you can also download it at https://www.birmingham.ac.uk/contact/directions/index.aspx


To access this information on the move, the UOB Campus Map app is available as a free download for iOS (on the App Store) and Android devices (on Google Play).

Travelling by car

Please enter campus via East Gate (Edgbaston Park Road) – see maps below. Student Ambassadors wearing high-vis jackets will be waiting at East Gate between 4.45-5.30pm to meet and direct visitors.

If you are using a satnay, the postcode for East Gate is B15 2TU. You will not need to pay to park after 4.30pm.



Travelling by bus

It is also easy to reach the University by public transport. A number of buses run along the Bristol Road and stop near the south entrance to the University.

Travelling by train

If you are coming by train, the Longbridge or Redditch train from New Street stops at the University station. It takes approximately 10 minutes to walk from University train station to the Great Hall in the Aston Webb building.
