Year 11 Easter Rewards Trip – Briefing Letter

Following the invitation to attend this year's Easter reward trip, we would like to update you on the final arrangements for the rewards trip to Alton Towers. The information below is in addition to the information on the original letter.

- Students need to go straight to the sports hall for 8:15am and no later as we need to register students and then get them on to the coaches.
- Students are allowed to wear non-uniform on the trip. Alton Towers is an outdoor attraction, so clothing must be appropriate. Students should have practical clothes, including coats.
- Students may want to bring some money for food and to purchase gifts. We would recommend that this is not a large amount. Pupils in receipt of Free School Meals will be provided with a packed lunch from the school canteen.
- If your child requires medication they must have these with them or they will be unable to go on the trip. This will be checked upon students being registered in line with your consent form and information on the system. Epipens and inhalers and any other emergency medication will need to be carried by the students. Students needing an epipen must be carrying two with them at all times.
- Students will be representing the school and are reminded that their conduct must be exemplary while on the trip. Students must ensure they are in a group of 4-6 at all times. Students must not attempt to purchase any alcohol from any vendors. Students who behave in a dangerous manner, or fall short of expectations, will lose park privileges and will not be permitted to explore the park without staff supervision. There may be serious consequences in addition to this.

We aim to return to school for 5:30pm.
