Students will be required to be in school uniform for their last day. At the end of the assembly there will be a box as they leave if students would like to donate their ties or blazers for students next year. Students will have time during the celebration assembly to sign books and shirts. Shirts must not be signed prior to the exam because **students will not be allowed to sit the exam with writing on the shirt.** 

The school leaving date for year 11 students will be on Thursday the 23rd of May 2024 at 12.30pm. This leaving date will be dependent upon the completion of their BTEC coursework and the completion of assessments that will provide evidence for their GCSE qualifications. If students still have outstanding assessments or coursework, they will be required to come into school after the half term break to complete this work.

The GCSE results day in the summer will be Thursday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August from 9.00am – 12pm. Students will be able to collect their results from the sports hall. If students are unable to collect their results, they can get a relative to collect them if they have signed permission from the student.
